However, as they age, their ability to capture carbon decreases, so at this point, they're transformed into Accoya, making room for new, fast-growing trees that can take up the carbon-absorbing role.



We are committed to sustainability in every step of our process. In 2016, we invested in a biomass boiler heating system, which heats our workshop and paint drying booths using our own timber offcuts rather than gas. This is just one example of how we're reducing our environmental impact.

With a lifespan of over 70 years and fully recyclable at the end of their lifecycle, our hand-crafted windows and doors offer an unparalleled level of sustainability.

From the sourcing of materials to production and delivery, they are the ideal choice for families looking to make a positive difference in the face of today's environmental challenges.



Longevity

Hand-crafted wooden windows and doors are the result of skilled craftsmanship, not mass production. Each piece is meticulously created by professional, time-served joiners.

Every mortice and tenon joint, coat of paint, and decorative moulding requires time and expertise to perfect. As a result, the initial cost of wooden windows and doors may be higher than uPVC or aluminium alternatives.

However, the true value of our windows and doors lies in their longevity. With a life expectancy of over 70 years, they far outlast alternatives like uPVC, which typically last just 15-20 years.

Unlike uPVC or aluminium, which can start to look worn out over time with no easy way to refresh them, our timber windows and doors can be repainted to look like new, year after year.

As trends evolve, children grow up, and homes are redecorated, your windows and doors can evolve with you.

Repainting not only restores your windows and doors to their original beauty but also allows them to blend seamlessly with new decor styles.

From the moment they're installed, our Accoya high-performance windows and doors start paying for themselves—delivering long-lasting value, timeless appeal, and unmatched durability.



Durability

Our windows and doors offer outstanding resistance to insect attacks and damage. Thanks to Accoya's unique properties, it's indigestible to a wide range of pests, including termites, creating a natural, highly effective barrier against infestations.

Plus, Accoya's exceptional stability means there's minimal risk of issues during assembly, installation, or in the years to come.

Accoya sets a new standard for timber reliability. After undergoing the advanced acetylation process, it is rigorously checked and trusted not to swell, shrink, or distort. With only minimal movement, it remains highly durable, enduring the harshest climates for an impressive lifespan of 70+ years.

Our windows and doors are crafted to be structurally sound, using traditional joinery techniques honed over four decades.

Combined with our dedication to sourcing only the finest materials, we create hand-finished products that are designed to perform seamlessly through both winter and summer, year after year.

Energy efficiency

With rising costs and a growing energy crisis, energy efficiency has become a top priority for homeowners choosing new windows and doors.

Whilst uPVC and aluminium systems are constantly being modified and adapted just to meet the UK's increasingly stringent energy performance regulations, timber stands apart as a natural insulator, boasting low thermal transmittance and helping to retain warmth whilst keeping the cold out.

By combining Accoya timber with high-performance, energy-efficient glass, our Signature range achieves industry-leading U-values. Our double-glazed windows and doors deliver a U-value of 1.2 W/m²K, outperforming current UK regulations by 15%.

With triple glazing, the U-value can be as low as 0.68 W/m²K - an impressive 52% better than current standards. All our U-value testing and declarations adhere to BR442 guidelines and the EN 14351-1 standard, ensuring exceptional energy performance.



What is Accoya?

Accoya is not a tree species, it's radiata pine that has been chemically modified to improve its performance.

How is it modified?

The modification process, called acetylation, involves treating the wood with acetic anhydride (a component of vinegar). This process alters the wood's cellular structure, making it more resistant to moisture and decay.

The benefits:

This modification results in a wood that is highly durable, dimensionally stable, and resistant to rot and insects. Accoya is the perfect product for windows and doors, but it's also trusted worldwide on projects that test its claims, showcasing its beauty, versatility and durability...

Accoya case studies

The Moses Bridge

Netherlands

The West Brabant Water Line is an early 17th century Dutch defensive line, created by linking towns with fortresses and walls. As part of a recent restoration programme, the largest fort required an access bridge. The fort is surrounded by a moat and was originally built without a bridge so it was a challenge to create one that would be discreet.

The solution was to build a 'sunken' bridge that sits almost at the level of the water, making it practically invisible as you approach the fort. The bridge is built from Accoya wood sheet piling on either side, with a hardwood deck/stairs in between. Accoya wood's durability and guaranteed performance in-ground and in freshwater made this possible.



The Royal Arena

Copenhagen

The Royal Arena in Copenhagen, was designed to host a variety of international arts and sporting events. Durability and aesthetic appeal were key considerations in its design, leading to the selection of Accoya as the ideal material.

Approximately 250 cubic meters of Accoya were used for the arena's entire façade. The arena seats 12,500 people, with additional standing capacity for 15,000. Accoya was chosen not only for its durability but also for meeting global environmental standards. The project architects (3XN), known for their commitment to sustainable development, found Accoya to be a perfect fit.



Bangaroo House

Sydney

Barangaroo House, a free-standing, three-storey restaurant, has become one of the first projects in Sydney to utilise Accoya wood cladding and the Japanese charring technique, Shou Sugi Ban.


Inspired by the potential of creating a building in the round, the unique split level restaurant was designed by architects, Collins and Turner, taking on a remarkable organic form clad in charred Accoya®. Around 45mm of Dowelled Accoya and 45mm of Half Dowelled Accoya® were laminated into a series of predetermined radii with a Shou Sugi Ban finish applied to create a striking charcoal appearance.







Our crafting techniques

Seamless corners

Mass-produced timber manufacturers that focus on speed can often be identified by their use of shadow grooves on the frame and sash corner joints. Shadow grooves are used regularly because they hide corners that are not perfectly flush fitting. Decades of bench joinery experience enables us to achieve mortice and tenon corner joints that are seamless, flush and almost invisible.

We finish them flush because we proudly enjoy having nowhere to hide. Our corners are perfect every time.



Flush-fit, colour matched trickle vents

Trickle vents are ugly, but ours are made from aluminium, not plastic. They boast a flush finish inside and out, with the outside grille being virtually hidden by our head drip when fitted in the outer frame. We paint our vents, so they are an identical match to the colour of the frame.

*Flush vent externally is only available in outer frame and head drip must be fitted.



Multipoint lock & egress as standard

We fit multipoint locking as standard, and egress escape hinges on all side openers as standard. As well as effortlessly complying with fire escape regulations if sash widths allow, egress hinges provide a traditional timber look, with the sash swinging open from the corner. Butt hinges with peg stays are also available.



Sash windows with options

We proudly offer 5 sash horn designs, as well as 4 staff bead options, 4 outside lining options and 3 external glazing bead options. This allows our sash windows to fit in with any type of property. Our sash horns are hand finished using our precision bandsaw and oscillating spindle sander.

In addition, we can offer any bespoke shape of sash horn to match existing windows as part of our Tailored range, from a template or detailed drawing.



Accoya all through

We don't cut corners on product quality to save money.

Cheaper, plastic based beads & astragal bars are often used on timber windows & doors in the UK to save money. However, we can proudly say that when Accoya is ordered, we use it on every part of the window including beads and bars, providing the peace of mind 25-year guarantee that we stand to.



Our crafting techniques

Three-coat, dual colour paint

We apply a three-coat professional spray finish to all our windows and doors, ensuring a perfectly consistent finish every time. Each coat contains 120-150 microns of paint, which is the equivalent of 10 brush coats. We can match any RAL or Farrow & Ball colour, and we can dual colour, giving a different appearance to the inside and outside of the home.



Externally beaded, glass sealed

Our windows and doors are externally beaded, which gives them the traditional look they deserve. Our glass is security taped in place meaning it cannot be removed from the outside by unwanted intruders. External beading not only looks better, but it also eliminates the risk of water building up in the rebate channel, which can inevitably work its way through an internal bead into the home causing damage to internal surfaces.



Twin mortice and tenon sash joint

Over four decades we've perfected our corner joints. On window sashes we take extra time to craft twin mortice and tenon joints, as standard, combined with star dowel fixing.

This traditional method ensures every corner leaves our workshop strong, secure, and ready to last for a lifetime of operation.





Entrance doors

Our range of 30 solid timber entrance doors have been carefully selected to compliment many different property styles.

To finish, we have a wide selection of decorative glass designs and hardware options available.

Because we use traditional joinery techniques, we can also cater for bespoke needs whether this be a unique door design, personalised glass or outsourced hardware.
